

ACC classes to be held in Elgin Center in January

Elginites wishing to attend classes at Austin Community College don't have to wait until the new campus opens in 2013. ACC will offer several courses at the Elgin Elementary South campus on Ave. C starting in January.

The center will offer evening courses starting Jan. 18. They will be in a separate, currently-unoccupied wing of the school. Day classes should be held at the center in 2011.

"This offers a chance for Elgin residents to take classes without having to drive a long way," said Dr. Luanne Preston, director of school relations. "We want to make life as convenient as possible." At first, the classes will be core curriculum, lecture-based classes. Offerings will be expanded in the future.

In addition to classes, services will be offered at the center that were not previously available to Elgin students, such as academic advisors, a computer lab, photo IDs and help with the ACC's electronic library resources.

"We are very excited about being able to serve Elgin this way," Preston said. "We've always had a great relationship with Elgin ISD. It's a great opportunity for ACC to be involved in the Elgin community before the campus opens in fall 2013."
